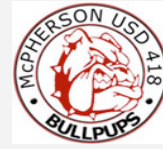

Course Description:

Materials needed for the class:

notebook, paper book pencil and eraser. You are encouraged to bring to class each day a simple 4 function calculator. We have some classroom calculators for use at school but it might be easier to use the same one at school that you will be using at home.

Types of activities taking place in your classroom:

Students will be involved in daily homework assignments, quizzes and tests. We will have class discussions on daily assignments.

How students will be evaluated:

Some assignments will be graded in class. Some assignments will be due and graded by the end of class. At times there will be quizzes given at the beginning or end of class over the topics from previous sections. This is a mastery learning class and retests will be given most chapters. It is the responsibility of the student to take the retakes when scheduled. Daily assignments are 10%, Quizzes 20% and Chapter Tests 70 % of their semester grade.

Discipline rules and expectations:

DO NOT INFRINGE ON THE TEACHER'S RIGHT TO TEACH AND THE OTHER STUDENTS RIGHT TO LEARN! Anything done that impedes this process will result in consequences. 1) when the teacher is talking or a student is talking, everyone else should be listening 2) bring necessary supplies to class each day 3) keep you hands to yourself 4) follow the rules of the student handbook 5) behave as a young adult

Consequences for inappropriate classroom behavior:

) Cheating will not be tolerated. If you are caught cheating your parent(s) or guardian will be notified and you will be referred to the office for discipline. Students should act in a positive way as a young adult. If there is inappropriate behavior all circumstances will be dealt with on an individual basis. If necessary a referral to an administrator will result. Students that are tardy to class will be assigned the time they are late plus 15 minutes makeup time. Excessive tardies will result in an office referral.

I will be available before and after school to help those students that have questions or need additional help. IF you need to talk to me during the school day please call between 10:15-10:45, if possible. As per school policy no cell phones in class. Students can have music devices in class but can only be used while the teacher is not talking.

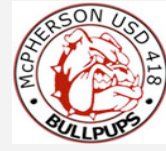
