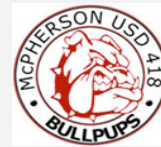

Class Principles of Technology

Period 3rd hour

Course Description:

Principles of technology teaches students applications of physics principles. Students will learn science theory and applications involving motion, force, work and energy.

Materials needed for the class:

Each student is required to bring the following to each class: a notebook, scientific calculator, and a mechanical pencil to take notes and complete homework.

Types of activities taking place in your classroom:

Students will be required to complete assignments (book assignments and worksheets), mini labs and regular labs with written reports, projects, quizzes and tests. Due dates for each assignment, lab, project... will be stated at the time it is assigned. Due to all the class time provided to complete assignments, no late work will be accepted unless the work is late because of an excused absence. If you miss class for any reason at all, it is your responsibility to get your assignments in a timely manner. Make up of tests, quizzes, labs, projects and assignments must be done within two days of the missed date unless other arrangements are made with me. Assignments not made up will receive zeros.

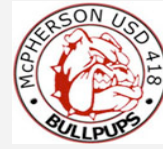
Discipline rules and expectations:
