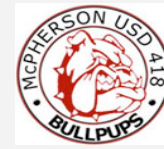

Course Description:

Resource class is designed for Special Education students to give them the support they need to succeed in the regular education setting. Students are taught different strategies within the class for making learning easier for them.

Materials needed for the class:

1. Blue or Black in pen.
2. Pencil
3. Homework that is not completed.
4. Reading book
5. Student Handbook

Types of activities taking place in your classroom:

1. Homework from other classes will be completed.
2. Study Skill Lessons
3. Organization Lessons
4. Social Skill Lessons

How students will be evaluated:

Every student receives a point for every 5 minutes if they are on task and participating in the class. If a student receives all of the points for the class they will end up with 10 points per day, which equals 50 points possible for the week. Students are also given points for activity completion, and project completion, so total points for the week may vary.

Classroom Expectations:

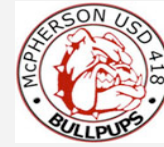
1. Respect yourself, others, and others property.

Other Classroom Info:

1. Tardies: If you are not in the classroom when the bell rings you are considered tardy. I will allow one free tardy per quarter. All other tardies will result in a 15 minute detention that will be served at 7:45am.

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2. Student Handbook: A daily planner is located in your student handbook. All classes are expected to be filled out daily for every class. Completion of you daily planner will count toward your grade in resource.

3. Make-Up Work: It is up to you to obtain the work that you have missed when you are gone. Do not expect the teacher to give you missing assignments without you asking.

Consequences for inappropriate classroom behavior:

I try to deal with consequences on my own within the classroom. If a student continues to break rules repeatedly they will be sent to the school administration for a meeting. If your student is having behavior problems, I will contact you to discuss the issue.
