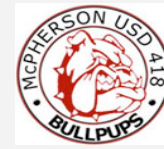

Class Sculpture

Period

Course Description:

This advanced course will explore various sculptural aspects in clay, wire, plaster, and stone. The additive and subtractive methods will be utilized in order to gain knowledge of the spatial qualities of sculpture. Research papers and Historical references will be used throughout each unit in order to increase comprehension of the information.

Materials needed for the class:

Materials needed upon advance notice: Cotton rags, pliers, wire cutter, empty plastic bowls (butter tub, cool whip type containers), other assorted "junk" items as needed. Small sketchbook and pencil are needed daily. The student is responsible for tools checked out during the duration of the course.

Types of activities taking place in your classroom:

Lecture, hands on, sketching, research, exams, critiques

How students will be evaluated:

The student will be evaluated on: Punctuality (to class & for assignment due dates), daily participation, attitude/cooperation, critiques, quiz's, unit exams, completed assignments, display objectives in a effective manner.

Discipline rules and expectations:

The students are:

Expected to take advantage of the learning process by avoiding disruptive/socially unacceptable actions. To be punctual to class with required supplies BEFORE the bell rings. (30 minute detention will be served for each unexcused tardy. Unexcused absence will result in a 55 minute detention) Responsible for seeing me about make-up work BEFORE class begins or after clean up at the end of the hour. (5 points deducted for each day the work is late unless PRIOR arrangements are made.) One day of makeup is allowed for each excused absence. Not to bring food, candy, drinks, gum, of any kind to this class.

Consequences for inappropriate classroom behavior:

If inappropriate behavior is evident the student will:

Be asked to correct behavior.

Serve a minimum detention of 30 minutes the following morning unless PRIOR arrangements are made.

The time will be doubled once/ parents notified.

If detention is not served, then an office referral will occur.

Extreme misbehavior exhibited will result in an immediate office referral
